

**All-Breed Draft Workshop**  
**Sunday May 18, 2008**  
**Bassett Creek Park at test site location**

The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of the Greater Twin Cities will be conducting an all-breed carting workshop on Sunday, May 18, at Bassett Creek Park at the test site location in Crystal. We encourage all dogs and their handlers to learn how to pull carts under the guidance of our very knowledgeable judges, Mary Alice Eschweiler and Ingrid Hubbard. The workshop will begin at 9:00. Fee for the workshop will be \$25.

First-time teams will focus on familiarizing the dog and handler with equipment. Novice and advanced dogs will focus on training issues and techniques and practicing with obstacles.

Pre-registration for this event will be available through the BMDCGTC website and at the draft test on May 17. Walk-in dogs will be permitted. Discounts will be given to volunteers and entrants for the May 17 draft test.

Dogs should have basic obedience training and handlers must demonstrate control of their dogs at all times. No bitches in season will be allowed in the training class or on the grounds. All handlers are required to clean up after themselves and their dogs.

It is strongly advised to have your own harness. You may order harnesses through Black Ice Sledding (New Germany, MN) or Wilczek Woodworks (Littleton, NH). If ordering through Black Ice, be sure to indicate that you are using the harness for carting, not sledding.
